

This document provides an overview of the Corpus and Repository of Writing (Crow)'s interface. Organizations planning a web-based corpus search interface can use this document to evaluate whether Crow's open-source software can be adapted or used as a model.

Design & Usability: Main navigational features

- filter by draft, assignment, and country (e.g., find first drafts of synthesis papers written by Indian students)
- search by exact word or word family (e.g., "argue, argues, argued, arguing")
- See highlighted writing excerpts

Interface Design

- **Dataset:** a large-scale learner corpus of English writing samples from university foundational writing courses, as well as pedagogical materials used in those courses
- **User audience:** corpus researchers, writing teachers, and students
- **Access:** registration required; different tiers of access

Figure 1: Screenshot of the main corpus search interface

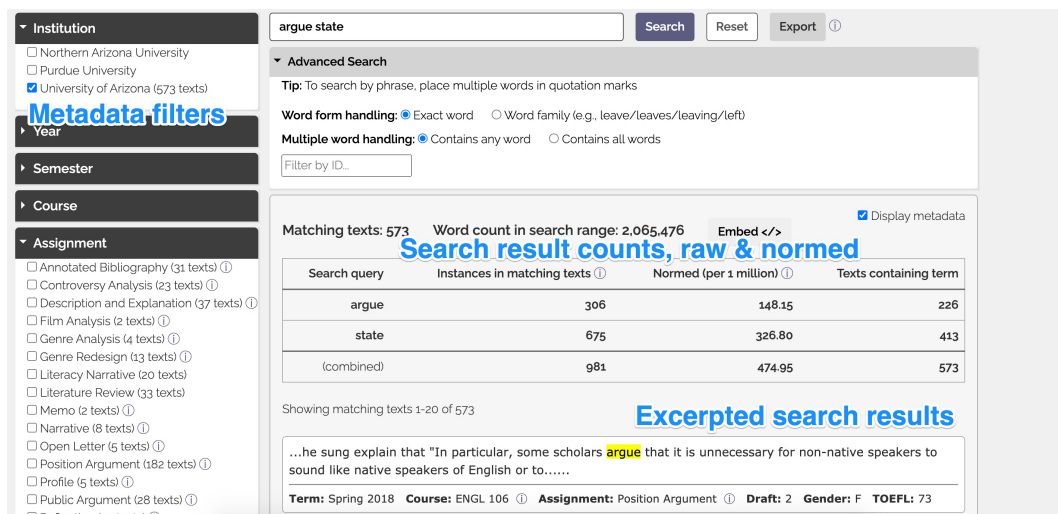
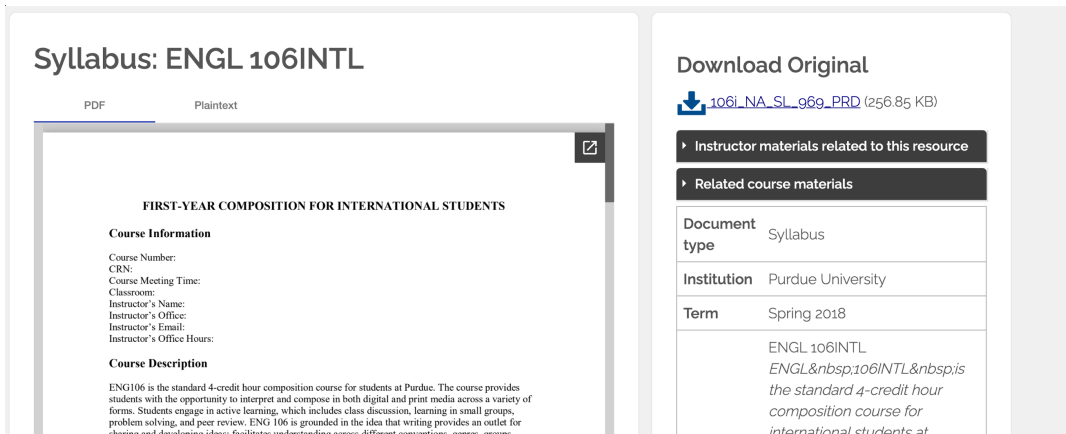
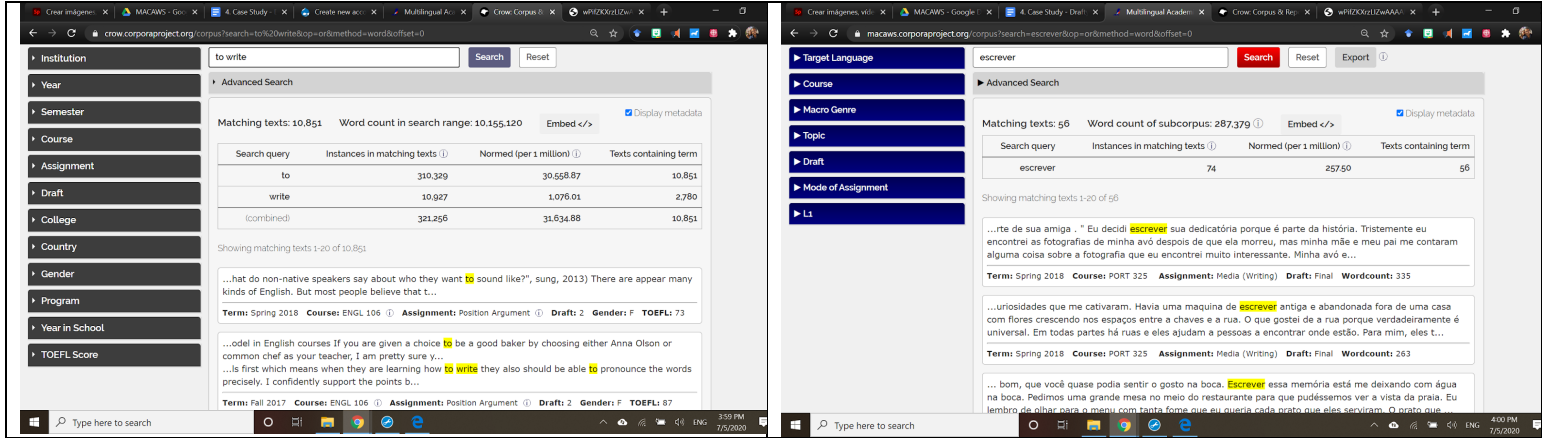


Figure 2: Individual page view of a pedagogical material



Case study: Adapting the software for the MACAWS corpus

MACAWS is a corpus and repository for World Languages. Though their datasets differ – most notably, MACAWS includes Russian and Portuguese language texts – Crow’s search interface fit the needs of the MACAWS corpus.



In terms of data and metadata, they differ in:
